Dr Corrado studied medecine at the University of Genova in Italy. Then pursued a Ph.D. in Neuroscience at the University of Geneva focusing on the developmental of computational approaches, namely dynamic network analysis, to characterize neurodevelpmental and clinical pathways of vulnerability to psychosis in 22q11DS. Since his Ph.D., Corrado has divided his time as a resident in child and adolescent psychiatry and research activity. Dr Corrado has been supported by a clinical scientist grant of the NNCR Synapsy to study the role of sleep disturbances in 22q11DS. Corrado has recently been awarded the SNSF Ambizione Fellowship, to study the contribution of sleep disturbances in contributing to affective comorbidities in ADHD using an ecological digital phenotyping approach and network analysis techniques.
